


MG Sight Line Putting Mirror Instructions



1. Place the mirror flat on the ground approximately 8-10 feet from the hole. Aim the center black line at the hole (or target if practicing at home or off the course).



2. Place tees in the tee holes to secure the mirror to the ground and create your gate.
Note: If practicing on turf or indoors, place the tees in the holes through the bottom of the mirror so they are standing upside down. Place the ball in the U-Shaped cut out.

3. View your reflection in the mirror to ensure correct shoulder alignment with your eyes over the ball. Align your putter to the gate, square face, and get ready to putt.



4. Swing the putter back and through to the hole or target. For extra swing and speed control, set a tee in a slot on the center black line, behind the putter.
